- Have you seen God redeem a relational mess? What did you learn from that?
- Paul in a letter he wrote the Philippian church years after his fallout with Barnabas encourages believer to look not only to their own interests but to the interest of others. How could that principle have been applied to this situation? How could you see it applied to situations today in the church or in your personal life?
